SEARCH WARRANT

Re: Bill C-24 Reforming Political Fundraising Rules

Issued by: Citizens of Canada

April 2003

In search of:

- 1. <u>Secret bank accounts of MPs and Senators</u>, and the names of the donors to their accounts, amounts donated, and date of donations.
- 2. <u>Donors to Paul Martin's secret leadership campaign bank account</u> -- the names of the donors, amounts donated, and date of donations since November 1993.
- 3. <u>Changes to strengthen Bill C-24</u> -- banning all secret bank accounts for politicians, banning donations by corporations and unions and other organizations that don't vote, and lowering the proposed limit on individual donations from \$10,000 to a maximum of \$1,000.
- 4. MPs and Senators with integrity who will propose and vote for the above changes to Bill C-24.

Reasons for search warrant:

- Citizens of Canada have a right to know the amount, source and date of all donations to MPs and Senators.
- Citizens of Canada (including members of the Liberal Party) have a right to know now who donated how much to Paul Martin and when each donation was made when Martin was Finance Minister.
- Secret bank accounts for politicians are a recipe for corruption.
- Corporations and unions and other organizations don't vote, and in a democracy only voters should be funding the political system.
- Allowing individuals to donate \$10,000 will allow wealthy individuals to have an undemocratic greater say in politics than other Canadians.
- Citizens of Canada need MPs and Senators to show that they can act in the public interest (as opposed to their own self-interest) by making the democratizing changes to Bill C-24.
